3. What do we learn about how someone is saved in this passage?
4. How do verses 14-15 connect with vv1-13?
5. What is your favourite verse in this passage? Why?
6. Reflect on how this passage challenges you...

WHEN the growth group meets:-

Read aloud Romans 10.1-15

- a. Discuss your “One Thing” from the passage being taught last Sunday.

- b. Discuss your answer to Q1. How does Paul’s desire compare with yours/ours?

- c. Help each other appreciate the great truths of Jesus that the apostle teaches in the passage (Q2.)

- d. From Q3., discuss what is remarkable about how someone is saved. Discuss also what popular “alternative methods of being saved” are eliminated by vv9-13.

- e. Discuss your answers to Q4. How do verses 14-15 connect with v1?

- f. Discuss how our thinking about us & our unbelieving friends is often different to vv14-15.

- g. Share with each other the mission field(s) the Lord has placed you on.

- h. Talk practically & specifically about how you each could have more beautiful feet on those mission fields.
