TO PONDER:

What do you think of the statement, "Knowledge is power"?

The next "Corinthian issue" Paul responds to is food sacrificed to idols.

Read 1 Corinthians 8:1-3

What might you suppose was the Corinthians' position on knowledge?

What is Paul's position on knowledge?

How might each position be "seen" in our church here & now?

Read 1 Corinthians 8:4-6

What truths about God does Paul declare?

What does this mean for idols and the worship of them?

How is this knowledge helpful?

How might this knowledge puff up?

Read 1 Corinthians 8:7-13 The apostle describes some within the Corinthian church with a "weak conscience". What can we learn about them? What is the true knowledge about the role of food in our relationship to God? How can such true knowledge damage another a Christian? What is Paul's challenge about the way we might use "this right of yours" that some of the Corinthians thought they had? Should a Christian eat at "an idol's temple"? Why or why not? What do we learn of the way of Christ when it comes to knowledge in these verses? Although we might not be in precisely the same situation as the Corinthian Christians back there & then, how might the teaching of this passage apply to us here & now? How is Christ the model & source of this teaching?

What questions do you have from this passage?
