8. Why do you think Peter spends some time establishing his apostolic authority and the authority of the bible? (1.12-21)
9. Why do you think the event in vs17-18 had such a profound effect on Peter?
10. How can this passage help us when we doubt the truth of Christianity?
11. Do you think that you have the same high opinion of the bible that Peter has? How would someone looking at your life tell?
