Read Matthew 17:1-8 and 2 Peter 1:16-18. What is revealed about Jesus? How should you respond?

Read 2 Corinthians 3:7-18. How does glory feature in this passage? How does this impact you?

Read 1 Timothy 2:1-6 and Hebrews 9:11-15. How is Jesus the perfect mediator? What does this mean for you?
