- **6.** Have a look again at verse 7. Does this contradict what Paul has said in chapter 1? Why, why not?
- 7. The sins mentioned in vs18-32 aren't meant to be a list of the worst things you can do. Paul uses these as illustrations. All sin leads to judgment, there's not anything that's worse than another thing. Thus, what is it about the examples here that teach us what 'sin' means?
- **8.** What do these passages teach us about living a Godly life?
