### **Read Romans 3.1-2**

4. What, then, is the advantage in being a Jew?
5. What does this teach us about how important the Bible is?

### **Read Romans 3.3-20**

6. Why is God NOT unjust in bringing judgment?
7. So, what is the role of God's law (both the laws themselves, but also the whole Old Testament)?
8. How does the law make us conscious of sin?

### **Read Romans 3.21-30**

9. How does Jesus bring justice and vindicate any charge of wrongdoing against God?
10. What does this mean for how we should view Jesus?
11. What does this mean for how we approach ungodliness in our life?
