DURING THE STUDY

Read Romans 4.1-25

- 1. Paul has been saying that you cannot be saved by obeying the law. You need to trust Jesus to be saved. How does Abraham and King David prove his point?
- 2. Why is it important (particularly for us gentiles) that Abraham was credited righteousness BEFORE being circumcised? (vv9-12)
- 3. How can we 'follow in the footsteps of faith' like Abraham? (v12)
- **4.** What is encouraging about vv16-17?
- 5. How does Abraham live out his faith? (vv18-22)
- 6. What does this teach us about the relationship between faith and obedience?
- 7. How does Jesus fulfil all this talk of grace and faith? (vv23-25)
- **8.** How important are the death and resurrection of Jesus when understanding the gospel? Why?
- **9.** How can you continue to be 'fully persuaded that God had power to do what he promised' throughout our long lives of faith and obedience? (vv20-21)
